

NCSD Water Conservation Program Grass Conversion Rebate Program and Submittal Information

The Grass Conversion Rebate Program encourages customers to replace turf with drought-resistant planting. Water savings realized by removing a lawn vary depending on the type of turf grass removed and the area it covers. If plant material is changed but irrigation practices are not, then little water savings will be realized. Replacing a lawn with a mix of trees, shrubs, groundcovers, and vines that create a nearly complete plant canopy over the landscape will realize the least water savings, but still reduce water demand by at least 50% of cool season grass or at least 40% of warm season grass if planting is well designed and the irrigation system is well-managed and highly efficient.

PROGRAM DETAILS AND REBATE AMOUNTS

Convert a minimum of 500 square feet of turf to drought resistant plants that meet with district and homeowner association guidelines. Maximum rebate is \$500.00 per property at fifty cents per square foot converted.

PROGRAM RULES & REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a District water customer in good standing.
- Landscaping must adhere to the guidelines set forth by Northstar Property Owners Association.
- Participants must use drought-tolerant, low, and medium water-use plants or native plant species in place of the turf (please see the attached list of approved plants).
- Pre and post inspections will be scheduled on a first come, first served basis.
- Rebates are available on a first come first serve basis until District's budgeted allotment is exhausted.
- Rebate program is NOT retroactive. Projects underway or completed prior to pre-inspection are ineligible.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1) Complete the Grass Conversion Rebate application with a signature.
- 2) Applicant must complete a pre-conversion inspection with NCSD Staff.
- 3) Complete the conversion with 14 days of inspection.
- 4) Complete a post-conversion site visit with NCSD Staff.
